## Updates from Dr. Pratap:

- SEA-EU NET SEAMEO Experts Round table on AMR just finished (10-12 May 2016, Hanoi)
  - o TROPMED co-organizer
  - o Opportunities; students and research staff can apply for grants
  - o Details of opportunities to be given later e.g. Fleming Funds; France
  - TROPMED Centres must participate and get involve in AMR. There are
    - different aspects where the Centres can focus: environment; social factors; diagnostic facilities/tools (LONGITUDE PRIZE website); surveillance of resistance in animals; transmission; use of antibiotics in agriculture
  - WHO Declaration of "Post antibiotic era"

#### DENGUE Vaccine Initiative in KL June 2016

- o Dr. Pratap to attend
- 10 countries in Phase 3; Sanofi Vaccine- efficacy 60%; rec. for use for children ages 9-45; 3 doses; efficacy depends on serotype (Dengue 2 – least effective)
- o Can prevent hospitalization up to 85%

# • APSED -Bi-regional Meeting in Manila

- o Preparation of 3<sup>rd</sup> version; one of the components is Capacity Building (short and specific courses)
- Zika virus is it present in SEA?
  - o More funding on Zika virus
  - o Suggestion for TROPMED to get involve in Zika virus research
  - WHO recommendation: should look not for individual disease but for *Aedes* borne diseases; also *albopictus* borne
  - Area of research: transmission
  - o Funding is available
- 11 cases of yellow fever now in China

TROPMED Centres should start thinking of:

- New opportunities for research and capacity building activities in health development (SDG #3)
- Internal Capacity of Centres to undertake activities in these areas of concern
